

08-19-21	INST\$ Invoice instructions for Nina Nina came to see us today for evaluation of possible amputation of her right front leg because of osteosarcoma. We have discussed that tumor metastasis is basically guaranteed at this time, but that we are trying to keep her comfortable. Her chest xrays show one possible tumor metastatic nodule, and her bloodwork looks great! Our concern, however, is that she has a new hesitance to use her left front, with a swollen flexor tendon. She is actually starting to put weight back on her right front to avoid using the left front. The problem with the left front can be tendon damage, soft tissue tumor, or neck problems. We feel that it would be wise to consult with Dr. Mason at Florida Vet Rehab (386-337-7106) to see if we can get her comfortable enough on the left front to make amputation of the right front a viable option for her. Keep up the great work with her supplements. I would just like to add Thytrophin to support her thyroid. Thank you for trusting us with her care! Let us know if you have any questions or concerns.
